1.2 Course aims and learning outcomes

The aims of the course is to provide students with foundational knowledge and sound understanding of positive and negative trends in development of relations between Russia and the European Union and to introduce students to legislative base of Russia – EU relations.

Learning outcomes:

By the end of this course students should be able to:

- know and understand positive and negative aspects and trends in Russia – EU relations,
- know the main legal acts regulating Russia – EU relations,
- critically interpret current situation in relations between Russia and the European Union,

1.3 Course requirements and grading plan

Course requirements

Students will be required to attend not less than 90% of classes and be prepared for class discussions. Conscientious reading of the assigned materials is compulsory.

Grading plan

- Class participation – 20 %
Students are expected to attend all the lectures, seminars and participate in class discussions; since the course is highly interactive, it is essential that students attend the seminars having read the materials for that day's class.
- In-class test – 30 %
Students will write two tests during the semester. Date of tests are defined by the instructor and communicated to the students at the first class of the respective course.
- In-class test – 30 %

- Essay – 20 %
During the course each student is expected to write an essay (up to 10 pages including literature) on one of the topics proposed. The essay should demonstrate the level of student's knowledge of publications on the subject. The work is to be presented at least 2 weeks before the end of the course.

- In-class presentation - optional.
Such a presentation (up to 15 minutes) is performed by a student once in the term. The presentation will be based on the proposed topic. The presenter should supply a brief summary of the information on that topic and offer a critical interpretation of the materials. At the end the presenter should also outline the main results of analysis. A few critical questions should further be offered for the class to discuss collectively.
